Habakkuk Study for part of Lent/The Second Half of March 2025 "Look at the proud!

Their spirit is not right in them, but the righteous live by their faithfulness." - Habakkuk 2:4

Christian theology throughout the centuries has been shaped by the letters of the Apostle Paul. Pauline soteriology (a fancy term for discussion about Paul's view of salvation) has shaped Christians and been a major topic amongst biblical scholars and theologians. One of the books of the Bible that helped Paul with his view of justification of or by God's grace is Habakkuk. In fact, Habakkuk 2:4 is quoted by Paul in Romans 1:16-17 and alluded to in Galatians 3:10-11. The Epistle to the Hebrews also references this verse in Hebrews 10:32-39. In referencing Habakkuk 2:4, The New Interpreter's Bible Commentary tells us that Paul uses this verse "for his theology, he does so to argue that salvation is a gift from God, gained not by faithfulness to he law, but by faith in Christ -- that is, belief in God's saving deed in Jesus. Such is the sense in which Paul uses Habakkuk 2:4 when he employs it as his theme text for the Letter to the Romans (Romans 1:16-17), and when he argues to the Galatians that no one is justified by obedience to the law but by faith in Christ (Galatians 3:10-11)."

All of the theological and commentary discussion on Habakkuk and Pauline soteriology leads to a major question we will examine during our three weeks of studying Habakkuk: "Who Will Be Saved?" Rev. Dr. William Willimon in his book on the topic challenges us in our thinking on salvation. One summary of his book states: "'Who will be saved?' is almost always a

question about them, and rarely about us. Thinking itself wrapped securely in the everlasting arms, the church has spent much of its history speculating on whether God will allow anyone else to join the party. But if we truly believe that salvation is God's business, and God's alone, then perhaps we should stop asking, 'Who will be saved?' and ask instead, 'How is God calling me to participate in the redemption of the world?'"

I believe that God is constantly challenging us to think about how we are called to live by our faith. Instead of judging who is in and who is out (God's business), we need to be about participating in God's redemptive work in the world. Our study of the minor prophet Habakkuk, will guide us in the journey of sharing grace and not judging if people deserve grace. I think we will be challenged as we dive in deep in our study of Habakkuk and salvation. I believe being challenged is good for our growth as Christians who are called to discipleship, inviting others to follow Jesus, and to the work of transforming the world.


